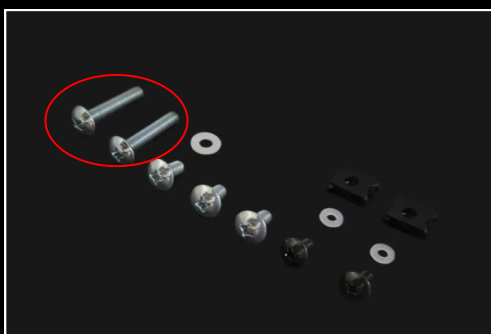


This fitting manual shows you how to fit the seat cowling set to the 2022-2026 KTM RC390. We have two styles, either race or street. The only real difference is that the street seat has an additional composite piece and keeps the stock tail light.

The first job of course is to prepare the bike ready for fitting the seat, which involves stripping the street bodywork off.



1) The first job is to fit BPSY-0424. This simply bolts on as shown in the pictures using the long M6 bolts.



2) Next, fit the seat support. Again, simple to fit. The middle hole fixes to the BPSY-0424 stay that you just fitted with the supplied M6 bolt, and the rear two mounts are secured with the OEM bolts as shown.



3) Now is time to fit the seat, but before we do that, fit the four rubber bumpers in position as shown. These give a little extra support under the seat for when you're shifting your body around through the twisties.



4) Slide the seat unit into position from the rear of the bike. The race seat pops on with the minimum of fuss as there's nothing to stop it falling into position. The street seat also goes on easily, but it is worth paying attention around the back where the tabs slip over the tail light. Just hold those out a little to avoid interference and the seat will slide into position.

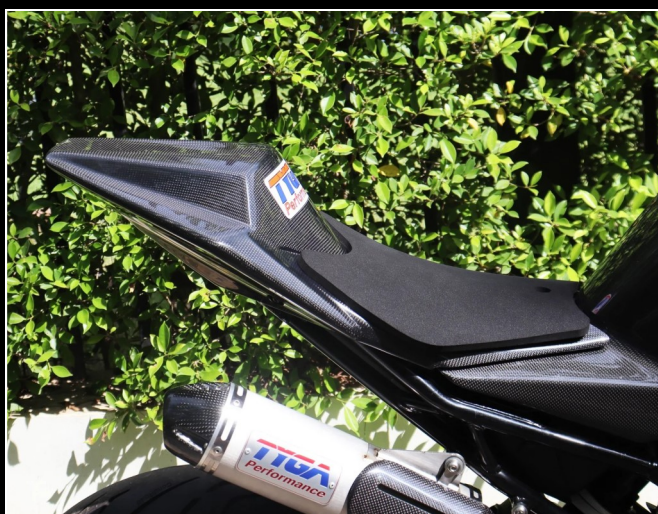
For the street seat only, you need to fit the in fill. This is held in with 2x M4 bolts.



5) The seat can then be finally secured to the frame with the the OEM rear bolts and the front M6 bolt.



6)) The final job is to stick the seat pad on, and you're done!



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
